- Q. Please provide a list of all subsea cables owned by Newfoundland Power and a breakdown of each replacement since original commissioning of each.
- A. Newfoundland Power operates only 1 submarine cable system in its service territory.
  The cable system operates between Broad Cove and Bell Island in Conception Bay. The submarine cable system consists of four individual cables that were installed in 1988 and 1990. The four-cable system consists of three cables carrying load and one spare. The Bell Island submarine cable system has experienced 3 failures, one in 2008 and two in 2012.

The replacement of the Bell Island submarine cable system was approved by the Board in Order No. P.U. 43 (2013). The cable system is currently being manufactured and will be placed in service later this year.

There are no expenditures related to submarine (subsea) cable systems proposed in this Application.
