3 Please provide specifics regarding the established mobile equipment replacement
4 guidelines Hydro uses with other Canadian utilities through participation on the
5 Canadian utility fleet counsel.

8 A. Hydro established guidelines for mobile equipment replacement, considering age
9 and operating conditions for the equipment, and based on information obtained
10 through its participation on the Canadian Utility Fleet Council. Guidelines for the
11 replacement of light duty mobile equipment are not specifically created as part of
12 this Council because of the diversity and conditions under which this equipment is
13 operated across Canada. However, there is informal sharing of experience and
14 information between similar member utilities regarding reasonable life for this
15 equipment and what manufacturer's products are found to be most reliable. These
16 discussions have not been recorded as part of conference or meeting proceedings.
