6	A.	Although the entire Digital Fault Recorder (DFR) is not obsolete, this project cannot
7		be deferred due to specific components of the DFR which are considered obsolete
8		by the manufacturer and which require upgrading. DFRs are required to be in full
9		working order when events occur on the system, as properly functioning DFRs are
10		very important to analyze system disturbances and to help identify equipment or
11		protection issues.
