What improvement does Hydro foresee with additional vehicles? 4 5 6 7 A. Current response time estimate for Protection and Control technicians and 8 Terminal station electricians can range from 30 minutes to 4 hours depending on 9 time of day, location of the terminal station or equipment, weather conditions, 10 vehicle availability, and the time of year (winter or summer). 11 12 With additional vehicles, response times can be improved by having more vehicles 13 available at the time of need, and if Hydro purchases 4x4 vehicles, response time in 14 inclement weather can be improved upon and be safer for the employees. The 15 improvement in response time would vary for each situation as many variables 16 affect the response time for each call out. With the additional vehicles proposed, 17 the wait time for available vehicles will be eliminated or reduced, thus improving the overall response time and gaining efficiencies. The added vehicles will also 18 19 permit more crews to work at different stations simultaneously, co-ordinating 20 outages and other maintenance.
