The following information was unintentionally omitted from the project proposal as 9 it relates to the variance referenced above. The category, quantity and estimated 10 costs specified on page 2, which totals \$330,450 is for PC hardware to be replaced only. The variance of \$204,650 consists of accessories for the hardware being 11 12 replaced (78 monitors and 144 docking stations), 30 laptops for both the 13 establishment of a PC loaner pool (discussed below) and laptops for longer term 14 contractors. The final component of the variance is for the purchase of ruggedized 15 laptop computers for field technicians (approximately \$5,000 per), where 16 16 technicians will get a ruggedized laptop as a replacement, and there are 12 17 ruggedized laptops allocated to be part of tool sets for other work groups. 18 19 Due to laptop failures as they approach the end of their service life, Hydro requires 20 loaner laptops to minimize employee down time and maintain productivity. 21 Historically, a brand new laptop, one that is scheduled to replace another laptop as 22 part of the replacement program, is temporarily assigned as a loaner delaying 23 deployment of the new laptop to its intended recipient. The establishment of a 24 loaner pool eases the distribution of loaner laptops for users affected by hardware

failure as well as those requiring temporary use for travel or training.

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
