
1 CA/KPR-Nalcor-16 Both Schedule A - "The Project" and Schedule B - "Isolated Island
2 Option" to the Terms of Reference refer to the period 2030 - 2067 as
3 follows:

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5 In Schedule "A" - "2030 - 2067 Primarily thermal units
6 for system reliability support" and in Schedule "B" -
7 "2030 - 2067 Holyrood replacement; additional
8 thermal."

10 Given that thermal based power and energy can be generated from
11 various fuel types, please explain what fuel types were considered for
12 providing thermal power in the 2030 - 2067 timeframe under Schedule
13 A and B. Please also explain, of the fuel types considered, the reason
14 for choosing and excluding (as applicable) fuel types from thermal
15 generation in this period.

17 CA/KRP-Nalcor-17 Further to the previous question, has LNG been excluded for
18 consideration as a source of thermal generation and if so, what
19 assumptions did Nalcor make as regards both the future availability
20 and pricing of LNG to meet the island's energy needs in excluding it
21 as an option.
