One of the areas to be included in the Roadmap is identified as Grid Inflexibility/Integration. One of the work products requested is to "assess the flexibility of the existing generating capacity in Newfoundland and Labrador, particularly with respect to the integration of a significant amount of variable generation (e.g. wind power)". In your professional opinion, is it conceivable that the work resulting from the current RFP could lead to the economic integration of higher penetration wind power?
