- 8 A. As noted in Section 11 of MHI's report Vol. II, MHI did review the aspects of wind generation as proposed by Nalcor including costs and technical integration limitations.
- 11 MHI's review was sufficient to formulate its conclusion that the 80MW limit was 12 reasonable for the isolated island alternative, section 11.4 of MHI's report Vol. II.
