Q. Consumer Question: In the report, Summary of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (NLH) 2010 Long Term Planning Load forecast for the MF Project, Exhibit 27, section 5.1.3, p. 16 of 22, Hydro Industrial Load, the energy requirements of the pulp and paper industry are 50% of what they once were because of closures at Stephenville and Grand Falls and the reduction in paper demand at Corner Brook (CB). The ongoing demand forecast for CB is "26 MW in addition to their own significant generation capacity at Deer Lake" (126 MW at Deer Lake). Can Nalcor provide the actual total island system load from CB (include Deer Lake) by year from 2007 to 2011?
