

1 Q. Consumer Question: NALCOR has previously advised through the RFI process that
2 there has been no material negotiations with Hydro Quebec concerning the
3 purchase of power from the Upper Churchill facility. Has NALCOR reviewed the
4 Guaranteed Winter Availability Contract (signed in 1998) as a means to provide the
5 provinces peak energy requirements during the winter months.

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8 A. The Guaranteed Winter Availability Contract (GWAC) between CF(L)Co and Hydro
9 Quebec, which extends until 2041, has no provisions relating to energy deliveries to
10 NL and therefore is not a means to provide for NL's energy requirements during the
11 winter months.
