2		a water management agreement with Hydro Quebec which removed the
3		restrictions upon water management contained in the power contract allow the
4		Lower Churchill to generate additional power and energy? If so, what would be the
5		effect on the rated capacity of Muskrat Falls and Gull Island?

8	A.	In Nalcor's view, no restrictions on water management are contained in the 1969
9		Power Contract. As a result, Nalcor does not foresee opportunities to allow lower
10		Churchill sites at either Muskrat Falls or Gull Island to generate additional power
11		and energy. Nalcor therefore does not foresee changes to the rated capacity of
12		Muskrat Falls and Gull Island resulting from water management.
