Q. Further to the response to PUB-Nalcor-95 which referred to the economic and
employment benefits associated with the Muskrat Falls project, please explain the
considerations given by Nalcor, including the priority or weight to such benefits, in
its DG2 decision.
A. Both Muskrat Falls and the Labrador Island Transmission Link provide substantial
economic and employment benefits. While these benefits were analyzed as part o

economic and employment benefits. While these benefits were analyzed as part of DG2, they were not given any weight or priority as they do not affect the results of the CPW analysis. Rather, these factors are evaluated and reported as part of the environmental assessment processes for both projects.

These factors have not been considered in Nalcor's CPW analysis as part of the current proceeding before the Board, as the Terms of Reference for this proceeding do not consider these economic and employment benefits in determining which alternative is least-cost. However, the economic and employment benefits that accrue from Muskrat Falls and the Labrador Island Transmission Link are important considerations for the Province and doubtless would be considered as part of a broader economic cost benefit analysis undertaken by the Province.
