10		Nalcor does not normally forecast future expenditures on a vendor basis and	
11		therefore detailed forecasts by vendor are not available. Forecasting of future	
12		expenditures is performed on a reporting category basis and the forecast for the	
13		period between October 1, 2011 and December 31, 2011 on studies, analyses and	
14		reports is detailed below. This forecast excludes charges for project expenditures	
15		for staff remuneration, third party professional services, rent, software, and	
16		communications.	
17			
18		Additional details for some specific studies are provided in the response to PUB-	
19		Nalcor-9 and are included in the forecast shown below.	
20			
21		Since the Isolated Island option is not the preferred scenario, no further	
22		expenditures are contemplated by Nalcor for this scenario.
