Re Page B-89:

Q. Describe in detail the use to which this building has been put and provide specifics of each such utilization in the last ten years, including the length of time on each occasion that the building was occupied.

A. This building was utilized in the mid-eighties during the repair of damage to transmission lines as a result of ice accumulation. Twelve structures had collapsed and needed to be replaced completely whereas others needed to be modified and/or repaired. Line crews used this camp and one other camp in the area for approximately three months. This camp has not been used since the mid-eighties. The frequency and duration of use of the camp are not the main criteria by which its need should be judged. This is primarily a survival structure, required to ensure the safety of line crews which could become stranded in this remote area during a storm.
