The existing public address system was installed when the Holyrood Generating Station was built, and consists of Gai-Tronics wall mount and desk station phones (with integrated speaker), ceiling mount speakers, and wall mount loudspeaker horns. There are 62 phones and 76 speakers in the generator area, maintenance area and water treatment lab; 29 phones and four speakers in the administrative office area; one phone in the Engineering trailer; one phone and one speaker in each of the two pump houses; two phones and two speakers in the waste water treatment plant; one phone and one speaker in the water treatment basin; one external speaker at the chemical storage building; one external phone and one speaker at the gas storage building; three phones and two speakers at the maintenance warehouse; one phone at the gas turbine building; one external phone and one speaker at the tank farm; and one phone and speaker at the guard house. The existing public address system does not utilize any personal pagers or other mobile communication devices.
