Q. What standards, legislative or other, exist that require the installation and implementation of this software in this time frame?

A. There are no specific standards or legislation which requires the use of a software-based automated work protection system. There is a stated requirement to provide a safe workplace and this implies that guaranteed isolation points must be provided to ensure the safety of workers. Hydro's experience has been that in a plant as complex as Holyrood, with literally thousands of potential isolation points, errors in issuing permits and providing safe isolation points happen all too frequently. This software will reduce errors and provide workers with safe working conditions, as required by legislation.
