During preparation of this proposal, Hydro had not received the final report for Phase I of the Holyrood condition assessment and life extension program. In preparation for Phase II of the condition assessment program to be complete under this proposal in 2011, Hydro requested AMEC to submit a preliminary recommendation prior to the Phase I final report, with primary focus on plant equipment and systems required for the future synchronous condensing mode. This was the most appropriate place to focus more detailed study in the upcoming year while awaiting a decision on whether construction of the Lower Churchill Project would proceed as scheduled. This is expected to be clarified before the end of 2010 and the final report for Phase I on the condition assessment will also be received by that time. Hydro will then be in a better position to decide the scope and schedule of Level II condition assessment work that should be planned related to the generation equipment at Holyrood. Unless unforeseen issues of an urgent nature become apparent after the Phase I report is received, it is expected that Level II condition assessment study activities that may be warranted for the generation equipment will be proposed to take place in 2012.
