2		At pa	ge C-199 it states that this project includes <u>inter alia</u> the replacement of eight	
3		ceilin	g mounted projectors. How old are these units and is there evidence that all of	
4		these	e units are experiencing such difficulty that they all require replacement at this	
5		time	?

8	A.	There are currently 66 multi-media projectors in service. The eight projectors		
9		sched	duled for replacement in 2011 will have reached the following ages in 2011:	
10		2 units 11 years old		
11		1 unit 10 years old		
12		4 units 9 years old		
13		1 unit 8 years old		
14				
15		The decision to replace a projector is based on several factors besides reliability:		
16		1.	Age – replacing units based on age allows for more accurate budget	
17			planning.	
18		2.	Availability – replacement parts for these older units are only available from	
19			the dealer while some components are not available at all.	
20		3.	Cost – the cost of these parts can be in excess of the cost of replacing the	
21			unit.	
22		4.	Functionality – these older projectors cannot support the screen resolutions	
23			of the newer laptops and do not display wide screen modes. This causes a	
24			loss of service and delayed starts for the presenter.	
25		5.	Management – these older projectors cannot be centrally managed so an	
26			imminent failure such as bulb life won't be known until the unit fails during	
27			a presentation.
