- P3-CA-NLH-06 Steel Poles are proposed for the new 230 kV line. Have composite poles been considered as an alternative?
- P3-CA-NLH-07 In respect of the malfunctions on the old insulators on the existing kV line, what are the costs for insulator replacements?
