If during core sampling 4 5 preservative levels are determined to be below the required design criteria (page 2) 6 what preventative measures are taken to treat the wood pole? 7 8 9 A. The philosophy of the Wood Pole Line Management (WPLM) Program is to inspect, test and treat all poles, regardless of the existing preservative levels found in the 10 11 pole. 12 13 To build a base of preservative deterioration rates, core samples are taken from ten percent of the poles inspected. These are taken to gauge the level of original 14 15 preservative remaining in the pole. Additional core samples will be taken during 16 future inspections to establish the depletion rate of the preservative to determine if 17 adjustments are required to the treatment program.
