The information is not available in Hydro's Generation Equipment Status (GES) database to document the circumstances around each of these coincident outages. Under controlled conditions, Units 1 and 3 may be taken off at the same time, provided that an alternate station service supply is established using a local station service feeder. It is when these units go offline in an uncontrolled manner (e.g., an unscheduled outage to the entire plant) and the feeder is unavailable, that the diesel generator is required to restore essential station service loads in an expedient manner.
