The 2012 budget is lower than other years because the average age of the poles being refurbished is much lower than the other years. This is shown in the following table.

For example, based on the age of the poles being refurbished in 2012, Hydro would expect approximately 2.6% of the 1685 poles or 44 poles to be replaced. While in 2013, this number increases to 11.2% of 2477 or around 277 poles.
