In the event that the proposed mobile generator is replaced with a more permanent solution in the next three years, Hydro will use the mobile generator as a mobile spare for backup in the event of a catastrophic failure of a diesel unit at any diesel plant, and as an emergency supply for restoring power in the event of a complete loss of supply to a distribution system due to a catastrophic event such as the fire that occurred at Nain Generating Station in 2008. As well, Hydro will use the mobile unit to supply power to customers while performing routine system maintenance and capital projects that require transmission line and distribution line outages. This will displace costs otherwise incurred to lease or rent the same
