A. Hydro is only seeking approval for one year of the five-year plan. Power transformer upgrading is expected to be an ongoing project that has variables that can change depending upon the condition assessment of the asset. As a result, Hydro is treating this as an annual program as opposed to a multi-year project. A program approach will provide Hydro with more flexibility to make changes in a current or future year when new condition assessment data becomes available. For example, each year oil samples are taken from power transformers and this information is used to create a ranking for the next year for oil reclamation. When you get closer to the execution year, new data may become available and the priority for oil reclamation may change but the number of transformers reclaimed
