On p. 1 of the Report in Volume II, Tab 21, it is stated that Hydro's Stationary

Battery Replacement Program is an "ongoing program" and Appendix A provides a
five year Battery Replacement Schedule. Is Hydro seeking approval of this project
as a multi-year project? If not, why not?

A. Hydro isn't seeking approval of the project as a multi-year project. This is a capital program that will continue for a number of years given the equipment reaching the end of useful life. The program plan will be adjusted annually to account for cost and scope changes, unexpected battery degradation, and increased or decreased loads. Multi-year projects provide a level of certainty about current and subsequent year scope, costs and timing of the capital expenditure. Where Hydro has expectations of changes in scope or forecast cost in subsequent years of a capital project expenditure it will only request a one year approval of the capital project.
