- Q. [Account R12 Right of Ways] Regarding the statement in CA-NLH-116 that operations staff indicated that a 45- to 50-year life would be reasonable for the life associated with Account R12 Right of Ways, please provide the following:

 A detailed parative explaining and justifying why operations staff believes
 - A detailed narrative explaining and justifying why operations staff believes that only a 45- to 50-year life would be reasonable including all meaningful and significant factors;
 - All documents which support operations staff's belief that a 45- to 50-year
 life would be reasonable;
 - c. Whether operations staff also believes that a 65-year life, a 70-year life, and a 75-year life would also be reasonable and to the extent each of the noted lives is not considered reasonable, all support and justification and documentation in support of such position including all meaningful and significant factors.

A. The operations group were provided a preliminary version of the results of the retirement rate analysis in order to provide comment and to verify the reasonableness of the preliminary estimates. The operations group provided a check of the reasonableness of Gannett's recommendation based on their experience and knowledge of the system and their comments were not based on any specific documentation. The Hydro operations group rely on the professional expertise of Mr. Kennedy in providing lowa curve fits, and are not in a position to offer comment on the comparability of the characteristics of the differing lowa curve fits.
