PUB-IC-4 Further to PUB-IC-3, how does Ms. Lee propose that the increase in depreciation expense that would result from such recalculation be recovered from customers?

RESPONSE: All things remaining equal, there would not be an increase in depreciation expense resulting from the recalculation Ms. Lee recommends. If the recalculation of the depreciation rate is not made, the resulting depreciation expenses will be lower than Hydro portrays in its depreciation study. If the depreciation rates are not recalculated, then the Board should affirm that the approved depreciation rates are not to be changed until the next depreciation study.
