Re: RFI 089, Tables 1 and 2

Undertaking to confirm that Hydro has included this catch up maintenance costs in the 2014 revenue deficiency deferral application for 45.9 million dollars.

As per the June 2, 2014 report there were 16 overdue transformers and 18 overdue Air Blast Circuit Breakers relating to the 2010-2013 catch up work. Per Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-360, Attachment 1, Hydro had included \$1 million relating to the maintenance backlog reduction in the 2014 revenue deficiency. As noted in the 2013 Amended Application, Section 3.23, the remaining catch up work relating to 2010-2013 was estimated to be \$1.2 million and was proposed to be deferred in the 2015 Test Year and amortized over a five-year period because it would not be a recurring event.
