# PUB-CA-1 to PUB-CA-2

#### Issued: May 8, 2014

- In Mr. Bowman's review of the "Industrial Customer (IC) Rate Design", Section 1 PUB-CA-1 2 5 of his report, he recommends a rate design similar to the one shown on Table 1. page 10 of Exhibit 12 of Hydro's Application. Would Mr. Bowman agree that 3 4 energy rates to Industrial Customers based on a two block structure with the 5 second block reflecting marginal cost would convey an appropriate price signal? 6 Please explain the response in detail. 7
- 8 PUB-CA-2 In Mr. Bowman's review of proposed changes to Newfoundland Power rate, 9 would he agree that a superior rate design would be based on an energy rate 10 (second block) that reflects marginal cost rather than doubling the demand 11 charge? Please explain the response in detail.
