
Re: Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro Combined Applications - Installation of Diesel Units at Holyrood for the Purposes of Black Starting the Generating Units and Supply, and Install 100 MW (Nominal) of Combustion Turbine Generation – Status update

On May 7, 2014 the Board issued Order No. P.U. 16(2014) in relation to the above noted application in which the Board stated that it *"is satisfied that Hydro should be granted approval to proceed with the proposed purchase and installation of an additional 100 MW of combustion turbine generation at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station leaving certain issues to be addressed in a full review with an opportunity for the parties to issue requests for information, file evidence and make submissions"* and determined that the issues of costs and cost recovery would be addressed in a further process.

The Board has now received the responses to the Requests for Information submitted in this application and is reviewing all the information filed to date including the regular updates on the installation of the 100 MW unit at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station. The Board has decided that installation of the unit should be completed before determining any further regulatory processes.
