# NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PARTICIPATE OF VALE NEWFOUNDLAND & LABRADOR LIMITED

TAKE NOTICE that Vale Newfoundland & Labrador Limited ("Vale"), through its solicitors Cox & Palmer, hereby gives notice of its intention to participate in the within Application, in its position as an industrial customer of the Applicant, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (the "Applicant").

#### Interest of Vale

 Vale is the owner and operator of the Long Harbour Processing Facility which is and will continue to be a major consumer of power purchased from the Applicant.

### Dispositions Sought by Vale

2. As the Application was recently filed and raises several issues that will be subject to Requests for Information and other pre-hearing and hearing processes, Vale does not have sufficient information to formulate at this time the dispositions it will request with respect to the approval sought by the Applicant.

### Facts and Reasons Supporting Intervention

3. Vale repeats the foregoing paragraph and states that there has been insufficient time for it to submit what facts it intends to show in evidence or for what reasons the Board should dispose of the approval sought by the Applicant in a particular manner.

### Participation of Vale

- 4. Vale intends to participate in the various procedures associated with the Application including, without limitation:
  - a. directing Requests for Information and other information requests to the
     Applicant and any other participant as may be permitted by the Board;
  - participating in technical conferences, pre-hearing conferences, and other processes associated with the Application;
  - c. cross-examination of witnesses appearing on behalf of the Applicant or of any other participant in any hearing on the Application, as may be appropriate in the circumstances of any hearing on the Application that may be ordered by the Board;
  - d. calling witnesses, including expert witnesses, as may be appropriate in the circumstances of any hearing on the Application that may be ordered by the Board; and
  - e. making representations and submissions, through counsel, to the Board concerning the disposition of the Application.
