NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO

**Addition of 100 MW of Combustion Turbine Generation
at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station**

THE APPLICATION

On April 10, 2014 the Board received an application from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro requesting an Order for approval of a capital expenditure for the purchase and installation of a 100 MW (nominal) combustion turbine at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station to be in service for the winter of 2014-2015.

Customers of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro and Newfoundland Power Inc. may be affected by the outcome of this application. The costs of this project, if approved by the Board, will be recovered in customers' rates. Hydro estimates the project may result in an approximate 2.3 per cent increase above existing rates.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Anyone can participate in the application by becoming an intervenor or by submitting a letter of comment. Intervenor submissions must satisfy the requirements set out in section 9 of the *Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities Regulations, 1996*. All submissions and letters of comment must be filed with the Board **by 3:00 p.m., Monday, April 28, 2014** and must provide full contact information including name, address and phone number.
