If yes, what are those additional characteristics which still require 7 clarification and when are they expected to be clarified? If no, then has Hydro 8 identified the requirements for further reactive support in the Avalon Peninsula 9 area, and will these requirements alter any of the characteristics (including costs) of 10 the elements included in Hydro's proposed transmission line project? 11
