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Q. On page 5 of Appendix C10, reference is made to a new 230kV line from Granite
Canal to Bottom Brook. Is it still the intent that this will be a 230kV line built in
support of the Maritime Link? What approvals does Hydro consider will be required
for this asset and any other that is listed in PUB-NLH-09 that needs to be
constructed in support of the Maritime Link?

A. At present, Hydro views the modifications associated with the interconnection of the Maritime Link to the Island Interconnected System to be similar to existing customer requests for modification to existing Hydro transmission and terminal station assets. The construction of the 230 kV transmission line between Granite Canal and Bottom Brook will be completed by Emera NL, as will the construction of the 230 kV ring bus at Granite Canal and breaker-and-one-half scheme at Bottom Brook. Hydro will complete the transmission line re-termination at Bay d'Espoir and the 230 kV circuit breaker addition at Upper Salmon with cost recovery from Emera NL. Hydro expects to make the necessary applications to the Board for expenditure and cost recovery from Emera NL for the Hydro component of the work.
