In a supplementary Capital Budget application filed by Hydro in July 2012, on page 3 of the attached report, Hydro stated that: "Hydro anticipates the long-term supply study for Labrador South to be completed by December 2012. Once completed Hydro will submit a supplementary application to the 2013 Capital Budget to carry out the recommended long-term supply alternative." On page 18 of the Addendum to the report Hydro continues: "Hydro is continuing to make progress on the long term supply plan for the area, and will be filing the final report with the Board upon completion in the first quarter of 2013." Please provide a copy of the completed report.

A.

The requested report has not yet been finalized. As noted in Section 4 *Long Term Supply Plans*, pages 14 – 17 of the Addendum, Hydro was originally looking at diesel generation supply options for the area. Since that time, studies looking at alternative energy sources to diesel for that area have been carried out by Hydro under contract for the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador. These reports are being finalized and therefore are not yet released. Hydro is of the opinion that the long term supply plan for the area would not be complete without the inclusion of these studies in the assessment. At this time, Hydro does not have an anticipated submission date for the requested report however, it is expected that an update will be provided by the end of 2013.
