
Consumer Advocate RFIs for Newfoundland Power

CA-NP 449 Please provide rates and customer impacts (in a format similar to that in CA-NP 197) for the Domestic class consistent with the proposed revenue allocation under the following scenarios:

- (a) A reduction of \$0.50/month in the Basic Customer Charge from that proposed, with the revenue reduction captured through an increase in the energy charge.
- (b) A reduction of \$1.00/month in the Basic Customer Charge from that proposed, with the revenue reduction captured through an increase in the Basic Customer Charge.

CA-NP 450 (response to CA-NP 262) “The impact on individual customer bills within each class influenced the tail block increases proposed in this Application.” Please provide support for this statement including the rate designs considered and the resulting customer impacts (in a format similar to CA-NP 197).
