Q. Please explain whether (and if so, how) NP is compensated for the transfer and use by other Fortis owned utilities of know-how, processes and practices developed at NP. If NP is not compensated, why not?

A. Newfoundland Power observes that regulated utility operating standards, processes and practices flow quite freely among Canadian utilities. Industry organizations such as the Canadian Electricity Association (which includes industry suppliers as well as utilities) encourage the free flow of know-how, processes and practices among its members.

 Other than skilled or professional labour provided by employees, Newfoundland Power has not transferred *know-how*, *processes or practices* developed at Newfoundland Power to other Fortis-owned utilities on any basis different than it transfers such information to non-affiliated utilities.

Newfoundland Power exchanges information regarding operating processes and practices with other utilities including affiliates but the character of such exchanges does not materially vary whether the utility is an affiliate or not.
