## **Volume 2, Tab 8 – Customer, Energy and Demand Forecast**

Q. Does the Company expect that it will face any significant competition from natural gas for space heating or water heating over the next 5 years? If so, please elaborate.

A. Newfoundland Power does not expect significant competition from natural gas within the next five years. However, as the offshore oil and gas industry continues to develop and mature, projects such as the potential construction of a LNG Transhipment and Storage Terminal near the head of Placentia Bay may increase the likelihood that Newfoundland Power could face competition from natural gas in the space and water heating markets over the longer term.

Newfoundland Power will continue to face competition from traditional fuel sources such as furnace oil, propane and wood. The degree of competition will largely depend on the relative prices of electricity and competitive fuels.
