

- 1 **Q. Reference: CA-NP-98: this response reveals that aside from the executive group, NP**  
2 **has 41 unmarked vehicles which are permitted to be taken home as a matter of**  
3 **course. Aside from the executive group's vehicles, why are these vehicles unmarked.**  
4
- 5 A. Newfoundland Power has 44 unmarked vehicles.<sup>1</sup> Of these, employees are permitted to  
6 take home 43 unmarked vehicles.  
7
- 8 A total of 5 unmarked vehicles are used by the executive group. Apart from the executive's  
9 vehicles, there are 38 unmarked vehicles that may be taken home by designated employees.  
10
- 11 CA-NP-384 provides details regarding the 6 unmarked vehicles permitted to be taken  
12 home by the Property Specialist, the two Transportation Specialists and the Customer  
13 Service Coordinators.  
14
- 15 The remaining 32 unmarked vehicles are assigned to Managers, Superintendents,  
16 Directors, Supervisors and General Forepersons located throughout Newfoundland  
17 Power's service territory. These employees are expected to be available to respond,  
18 immediately and at all hours, to operational or customer issues that impact safety,  
19 reliability and the environment. The Company vehicles are provided to those employees  
20 to enable them to respond promptly in the specified circumstances.
