1		CA-NP-384 provides details regarding the 6 unmarked vehicles permitted to be taken
2		home by the Property Specialist, the two Transportation Specialists and the Customer
3		Service Coordinators.
4		
5		The remaining 32 unmarked vehicles are assigned to Managers, Superintendents,
6		Directors, Supervisors and General Forepersons located throughout Newfoundland
7		Power's service territory. These employees are expected to be available to respond,
8		immediately and at all hours, to operational or customer issues that impact safety,
9		reliability and the environment. The Company vehicles are provided to those employees
0		to enable them to respond promptly in the specified circumstances.
