11		Total kilometres driven by the passenger vehicle fleet in 2006 was in excess of 7,000,000
12		kilometres, with 134,918 kilometres (or 1.93%) declared for personal use. The cost to
13		operate the fleet of passenger vehicles in 2006 was \$1,283,644. This suggests that the
14		cost associated with the personal use of vehicles in 2006 was $0.0193 \times \$1,283,644$, or
15		\$24,774.
