5 6	A.	The Canadian Electricity Association's practice for the collection of reliability data is to separate outages into two categories: sustained and momentary.
7		separate outages into two eategories, sustained and momentary.
8		A sustained outage is an outage that is one minute or more in duration. A momentary
9		outage is one that is less than one minute in duration.
10		
11		Because it does not currently have the technical ability to obtain complete and accurate
12		data on momentary outages, Newfoundland Power's outage statistics only include
13		outages with duration greater than one minute.
