- A. Yes. It is a generally accepted regulatory principle that public utilities should have a reasonable opportunity to recover their prudently incurred costs of providing service to their customers.
- In specific situations, the interpretation of "reasonable opportunity" is related to the regulatory mechanism that is in place. For example, "reasonable opportunity"
- may be interpreted slightly differently in the context of a pure cost pass-through
- mechanism than it is in the context of an incentive mechanism.
