Q. Is it the practice, as appears from item 6 on p. F-13, that Senior Management
reviews and revises capital budget items after approval by the Board of
Commissioners of Public Utilities?

A. It is not the practice of Hydro senior management to review and revise capital budget items following receipt of approval by the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities. Capital budget proposals are often prepared in excess of one year prior to implementation. During the intervening period, new information can become available, conditions can change or assumptions may be found to be incorrect, which may change the desirability or viability of a project. When management determines that such changes indicate that it is in the best interest of Hydro's legislated requirement of providing the least cost reliable power and energy to alter a project, then Hydro may revise or even cancel an approved project.
