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Q. Provide details as to the current condition of the road which are causing the
 need for these expenditures, setting out full reasons as to why "the road

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- Significant upgrades are required for a number of reasons including the following:
 - Most of the road topping placed 25 years ago is now gone as a result of weathering, grading and snow clearing.
 - Road topping has been lost over the shoulders, causing the road to be
 wider in some places which is causing damage and blockage to some
 culverts. Infilling of ditches also occurs which causes more problems in
 relation to run-off control and drainage.
 - Partial flow blockage in culverts is due to ditch erosion which could eventually lead to road overtopping and possible washouts.
 - Surface is very rough containing cobble sized rocks. The road condition leads to high vehicle maintenance costs as a result of travelling over this road on a daily basis.
