2 available? Why or why not?

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5 A. The information from the generating unit assessments and the various
6 feasibility studies proposed under this study are all required to determine the
7 most cost effective manner to produce electricity from this facility. The cost of
8 extending the life of the plant, with any emission reduction technologies
9 required, will be compared with redevelopment costs and with the costs of
10 other sources of generation. All the information is required to make informed
11 decisions about the future of the Holyrood Generating Station
