3	Q.	Over what period of time have the fuel tanks at William's Harbour not been
4		ULC compliant?
5		
6		
7	A.	Two of the existing fuel tanks at William's Harbour are thirty-one years old
8		and two are nineteen years old. The tanks are not currently ULC compliant,
9		and therefore are not compliant with the Storage and Handling of Gasoline
10		and Associated Products Regulations, 2003. This legislation requires that
11		storage tanks be constructed and shop tested in accordance with ULC
12		CAN4-S601, latest edition, and that they bear a ULC label.
13		
14		These tanks are constructed to unidentified standards, and therefore cannot
15		be certified to current ULC standards. Two of the tanks are damaged
16		beyond ULC refurbishment criteria, as outlined in ULC publication Technical
17		Supplement ULC-S601(A)-2001 for Refurbishment of Steel Aboveground
18		Horizontal Tanks for Flammable and Combustible Liquids.
