

#### Island Supply Notes For March 28, 2024

- A As of 0800 hours, May 21, 2023, Holyrood Unit 2 unavailable due to forced extension to planned outage (170 MW).
- As of 2059 hours, July 13, 2023, Stephenville Gas Turbine unavailable due to forced outage (50 MW).
- As of 1400 hours, February 06, 2024, St. Anthony Diesel Plant available at 8.7 MW due to forced derating (9.7 MW).
- As of 1102 hours, March 06, 2024, Holyrood Unit 1 available at 160 MW (170 MW).
- As of 0851 hours, March 24, 2024, Hinds Lake Unit unavailable due to planned outage (75 MW).
- As of 1622 hours, March 27, 2024, Holyrood Unit 3 unavailable due to forced outage (150 MW).
- G As of 2013 hours, March 27, 2024, Labrador Island Link available at 450 MW due to forced derating (700 MW) Bipole.

### Island Supply Notes For March 29, 2024

Notes: 1. Generation outages for running and corrective maintenance are included. These are not unusual for power system operations. They generally do not impact customer supply. Hydro schedules outages to system equipment whenever possible to coincide with periods when customer demands are low and sufficient supply reserves are available. However, from time to time equipment outages are necessary and reserves may be impacted.

- 4. Gross output from all Island sources (including Note 4).
- 5. NLH Island Power Purchases include: ML Imports, Exploits Generation, Rattle Brook, Star Lake, Wind Generation and capacity assistance (when applicable).
