1	Q.	Has Hydro completed an agreement with Corner Brook Pulp & Paper (CBPP) for
2		interruptible power for the coming winter and beyond; i.e. winter of 2014/15 and
3		beyond? If so, what are the terms, conditions and price?
4		
5		
6	A.	Hydro filed a work plan for securing interruptible loads with the Board in its June
7		16, 2014 Generation Availability Report and is currently working through each of
8		the items indicated in the work plan, including entering into interruptible
9		arrangements.
10		
11		Hydro has contacted all its Industrial Customers. Hydro is currently awaiting
12		response from some customers as to their ability to participate in an interruptible
13		service and/or capacity assistance arrangements based on their operational
14		requirements. A number of meetings have been held with CBPP and Vale, which
15		have the highest potential of providing significant levels of interruptible load.
16		
17		Discussions to date have addressed the magnitude of interruptible and/or capacity
18		assistance that each Industrial Customer could potentially provide, as well as the
19		costs associated with interrupting their operations and any foreseeable limitations
20		to the provision of the service.
