1	Q.	Referencing page iii of the Board's May 15, 2014 Interim Report on Supply Issues
2		and Power Outages on the Island Interconnected System, the Board includes as a
3		key priority action "complete negotiations in relation to interruptible load and, to
4		the extent that it can secure economically available interruptible load, have a
5		contract in place". On what basis will Hydro determine the amounts of
6		"economically available" interruptible load from Industrial Customers and what
7		process will Hydro follow to gain approval of these interruptible contracts?
8		
9		
10	A.	Hydro is seeking input from its Industrial Customers regarding their costs associated
11		with provision of interruptible capacity and comparing it to Hydro's incremental
12		cost to supply peak load. Hydro is also reviewing its forecast load requirements and
13		load duration models for the upcoming winter season to determine the potential
14		frequency of utilization of interruptible load.
15		
16		Hydro will determine the appropriate process for approval of interruptible
17		arrangements based on the ultimate form of arrangements contemplated. Hydro
18		will either negotiate contracts with Industrial Customers and bring the contracts to
19		the Board for approval or bring an interruptible rate offering to the Board for
20		approval and have Industrial Customers apply under that offering.
